Our Anthem Today “This We Know”

Chief Seattle was nearly 70 years old in the Spring of 1855 when he signed the Point Elliot Treaty, a document which stripped his people of their ancestral home in the Puget Sound area of the northwest Pacific Coast. His tribe, the Duwamish, was a peaceful people with a rich culture tied closely to the plants and animals, air, water and land that surrounded them. He said that day, “My people flee the white man as morning mist flees the rising sun. It matters little where we pass the rest of our days, they will not be many. Our night promises to be dark...a few more moons...a few more winters.” After putting his name to the document Chief Seattle rose to address the crowd. His simple, eloquent statement about the interdependence of all life includes the text “This I Know.”

The original **satb**, four-language version (English, Deutsch, Francais, Espanol) of “This We Know” was prepared for the First World Symposium on Choral Music held in Vienna in August, 1987. It is dedicated to the International Federation for Choral Music and to the abiding wisdom and spirit of Chief Seattle. *Dona nobis pacem.*

As Black Elk says in his book The Sacred Pipe, it is hoped that this piece “will help in bringing peace upon the earth, not only among humankind, but within each person and between the whole of creation.”
