Welcome, friends! Merry Christmas! The baby is born in Bethlehem. If you are ready to worship together, shout, Amen! Amen!

Angels are singing, the shepherds are rejoicing, because the baby is born in Bethlehem. If you are ready to sing for joy, stomp your feet and shout Amen! (And stomp your feet!)
